As this is provisional data - adjustments will be made in future monthly updates.



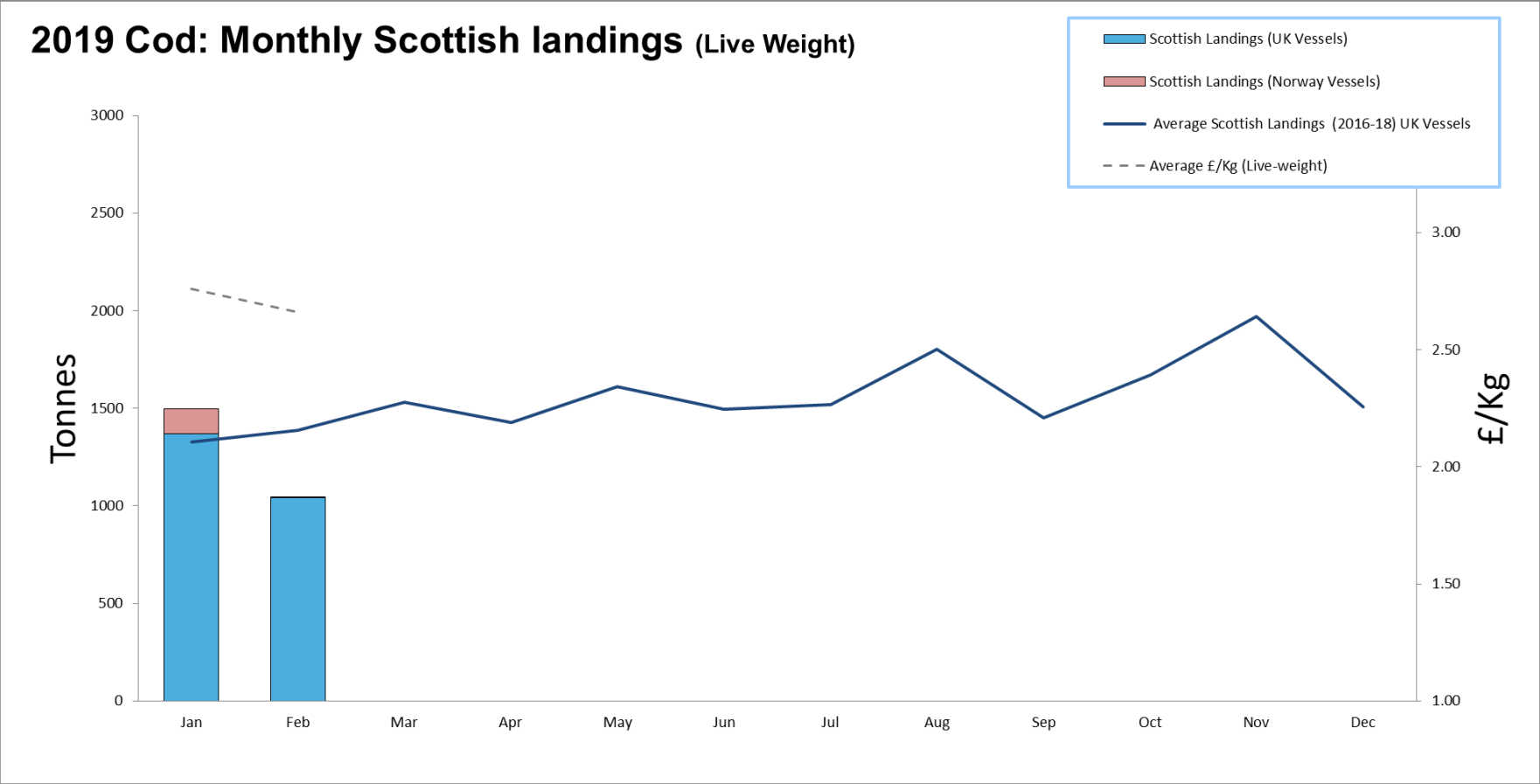

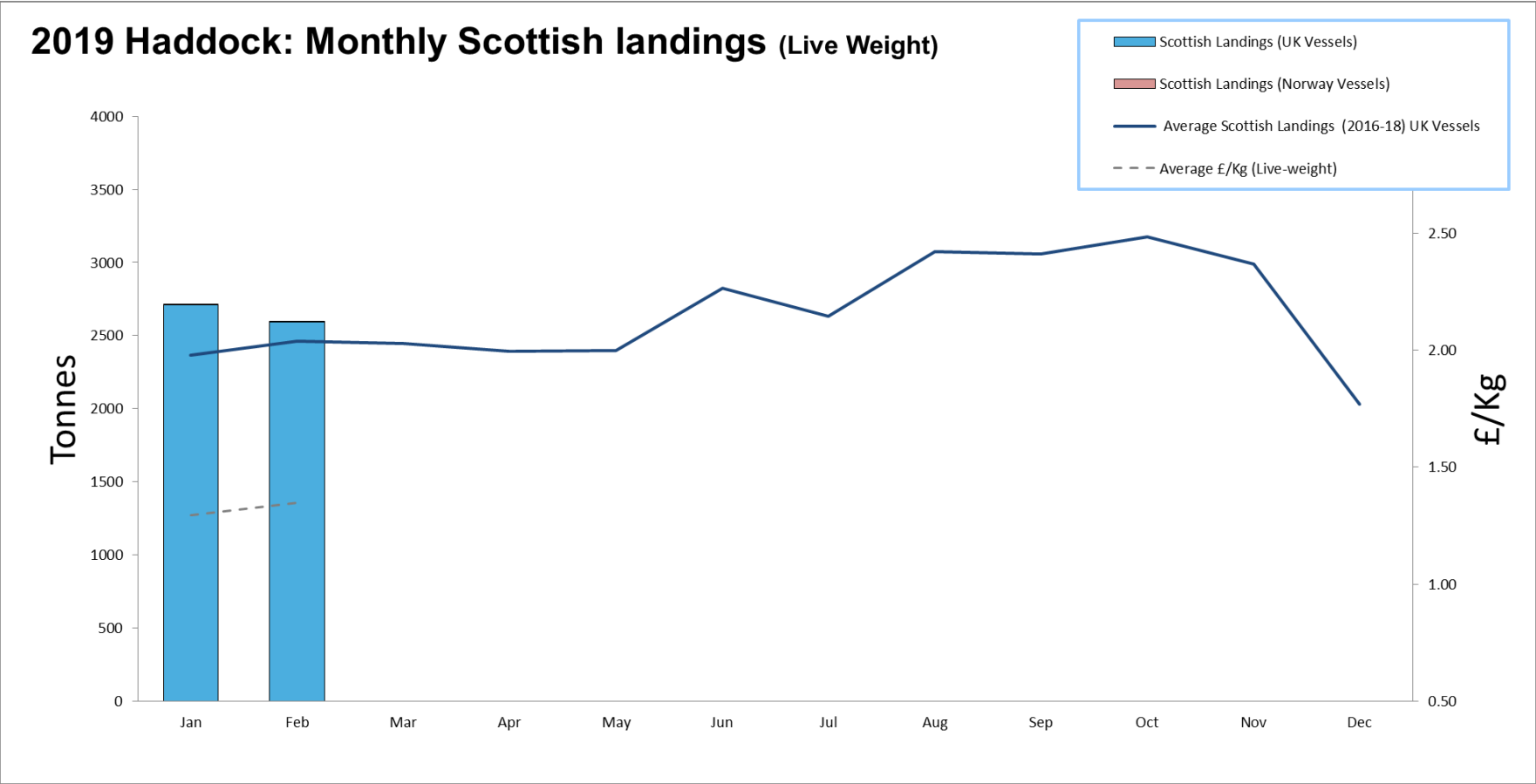

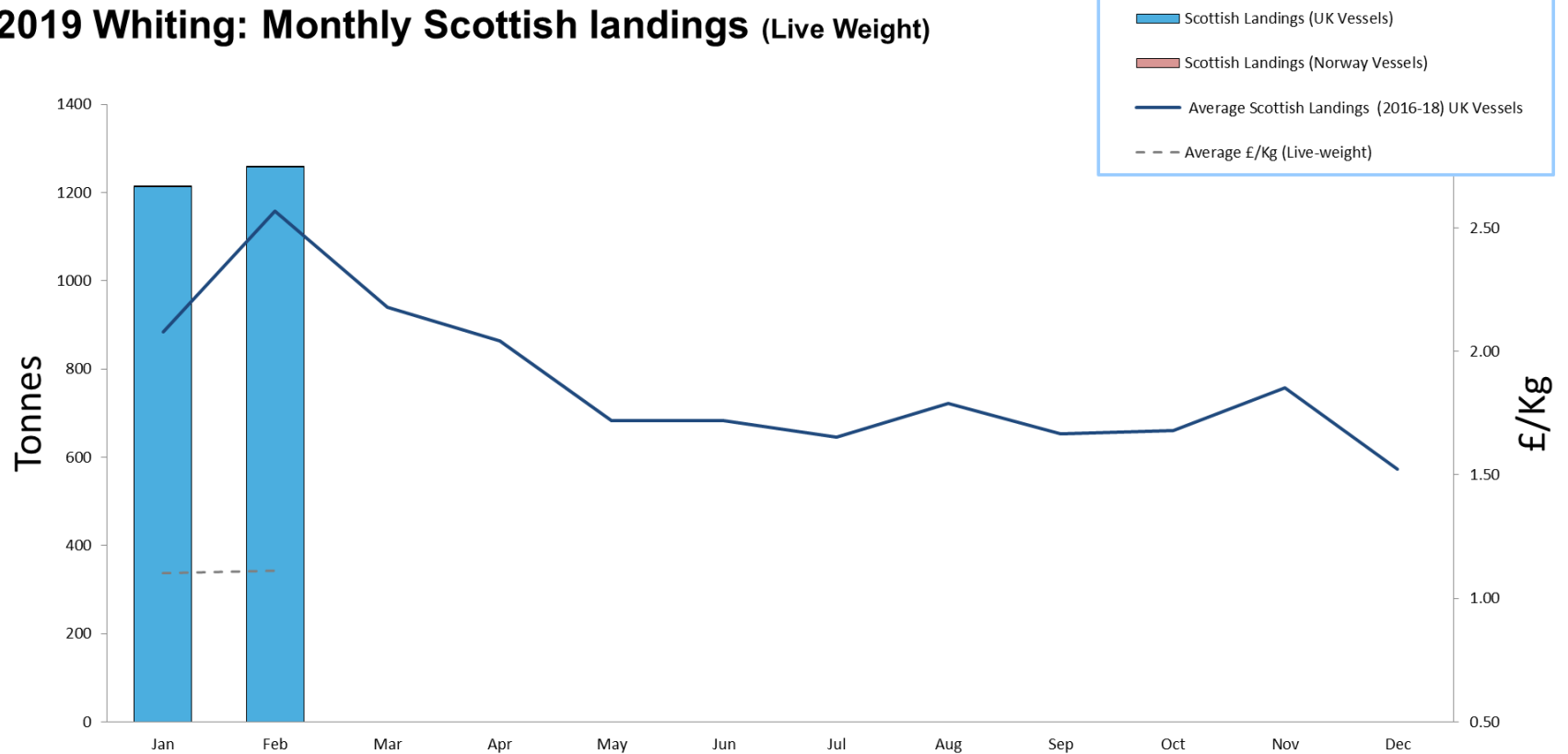
Haddock: - 2019 Landings To Date



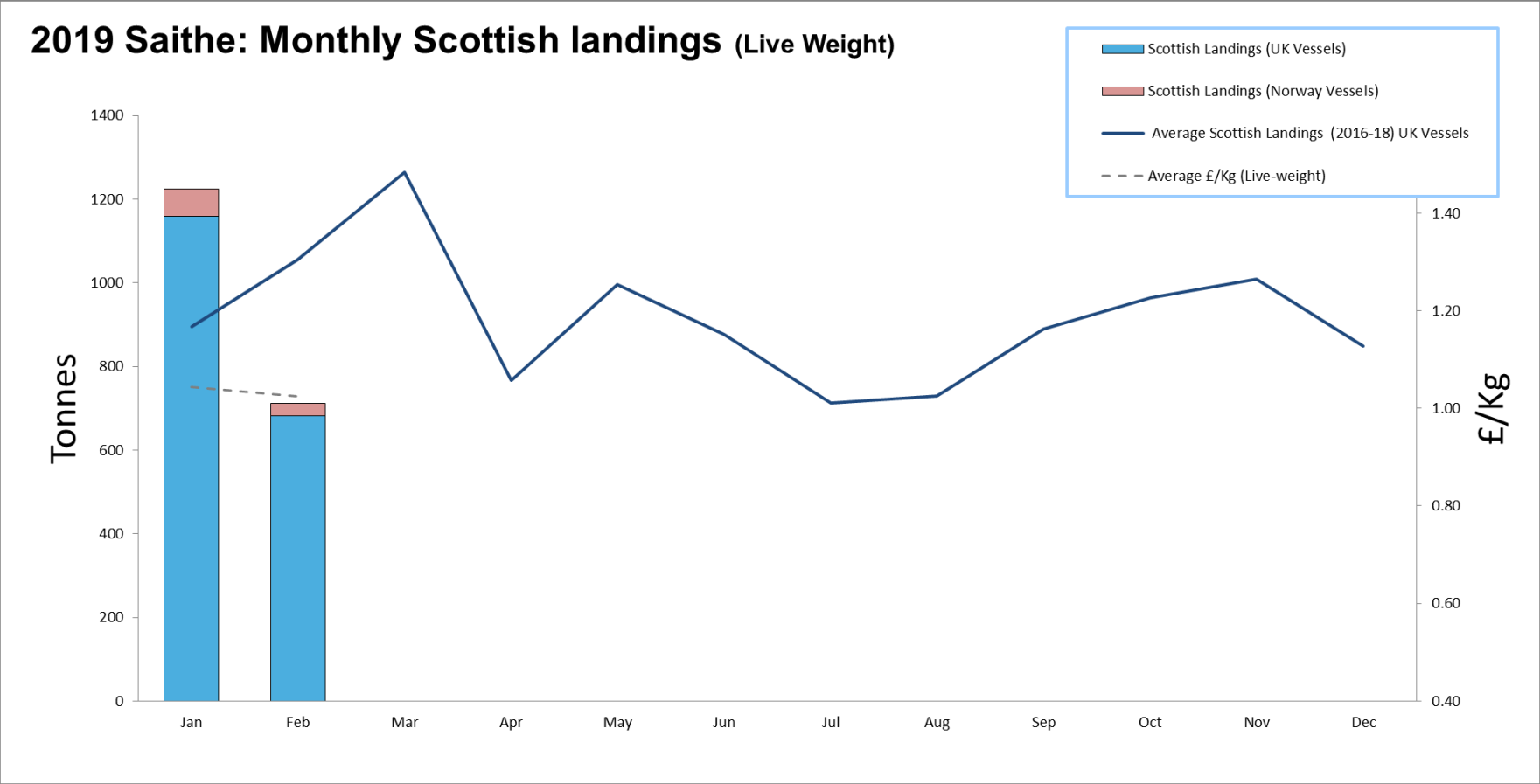
Whiting: - 2019 Landings To Date



2019 Whiting: Monthly Scottish landings (Live Weight)



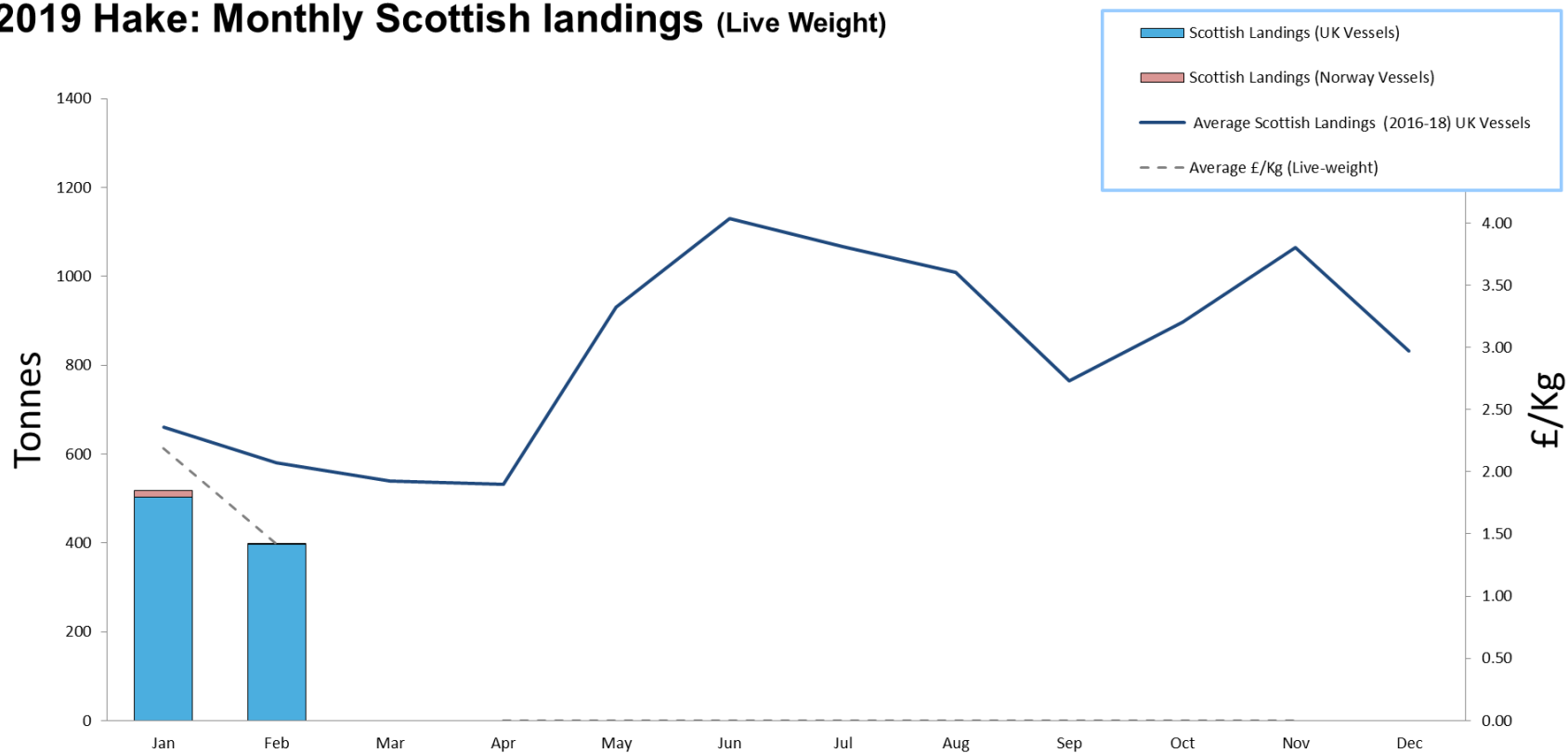
Saithe: - 2019 Landings To Date



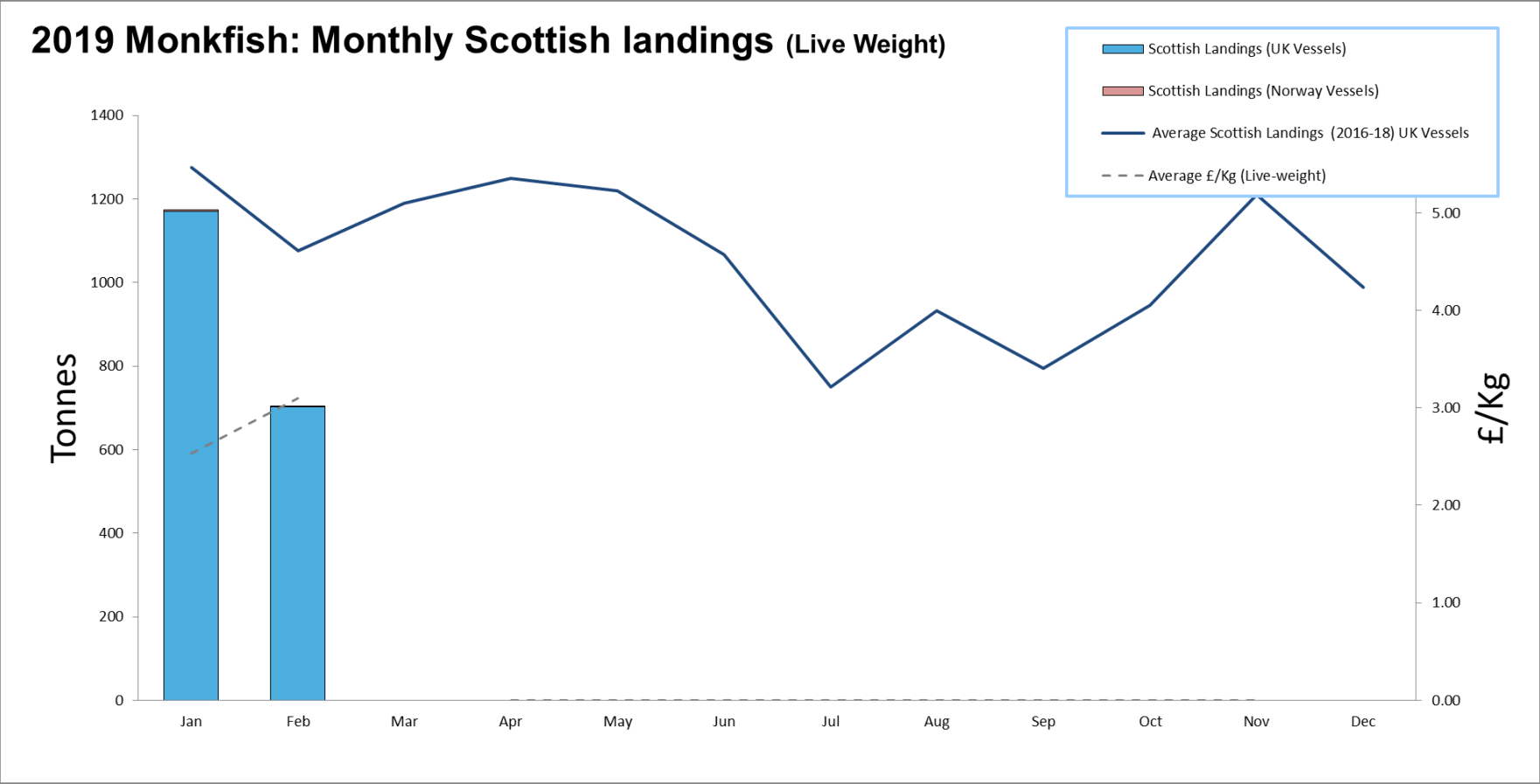
Hake: - 2019 Landings To Date



2019 Hake: Monthly Scottish landings (Live Weight)



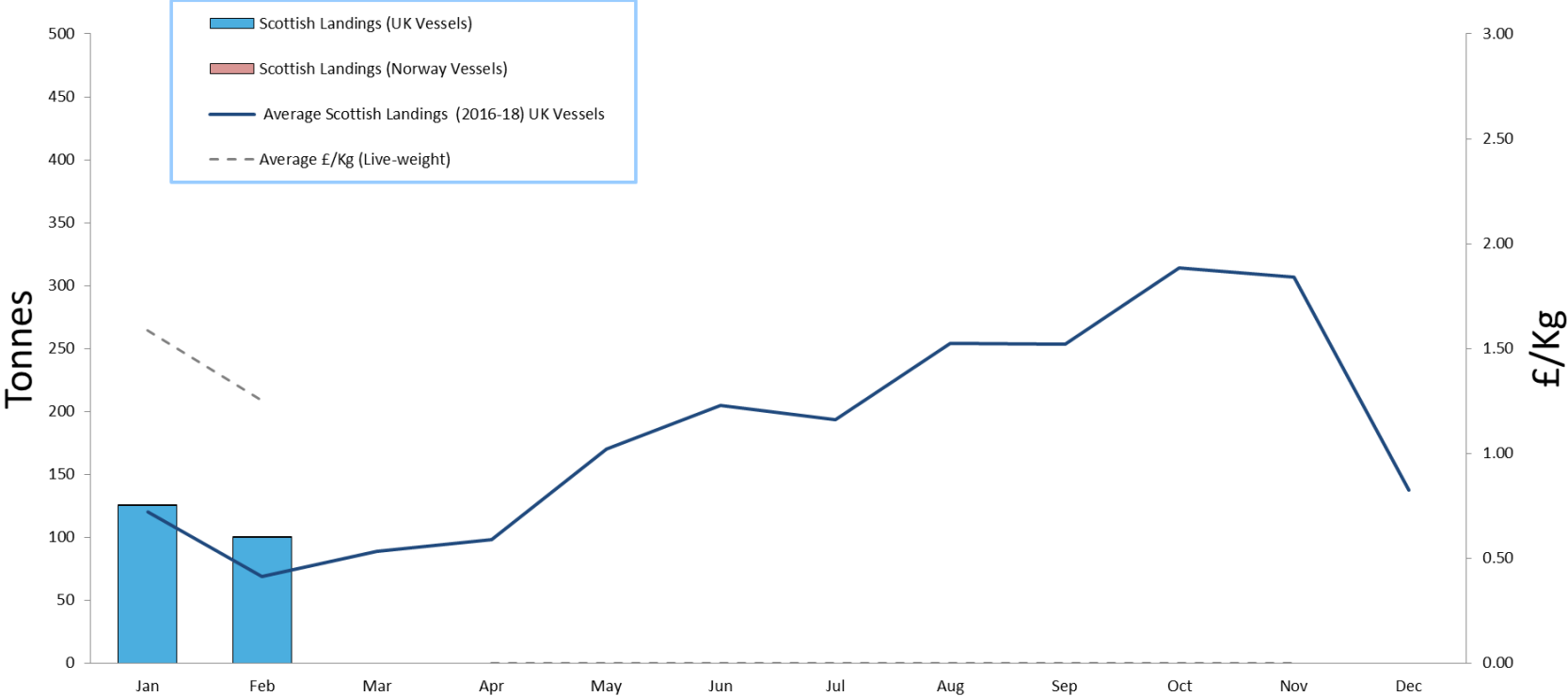

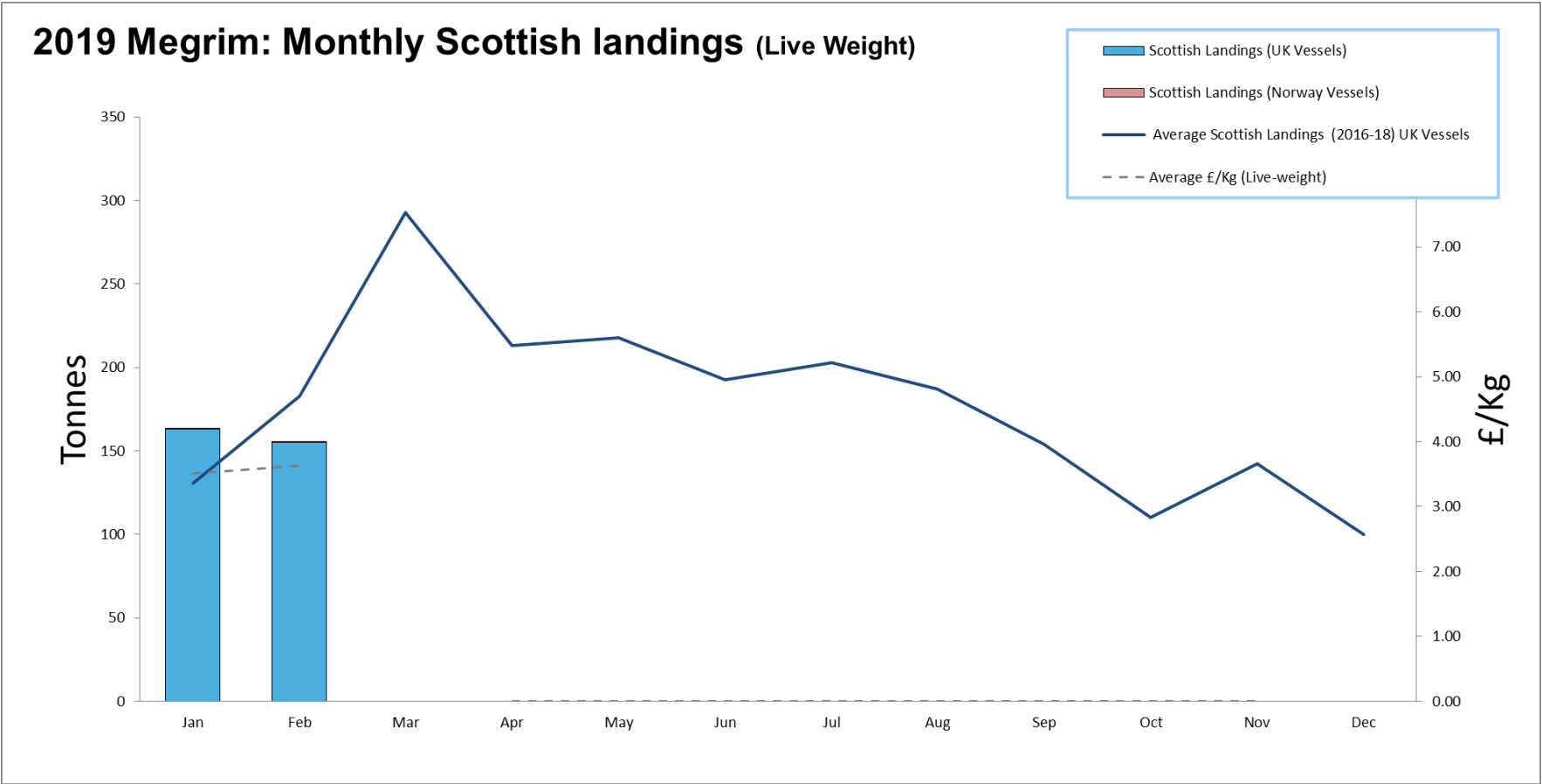
Plaice: - 2019 Landings To Date
