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Scottish scallop landings

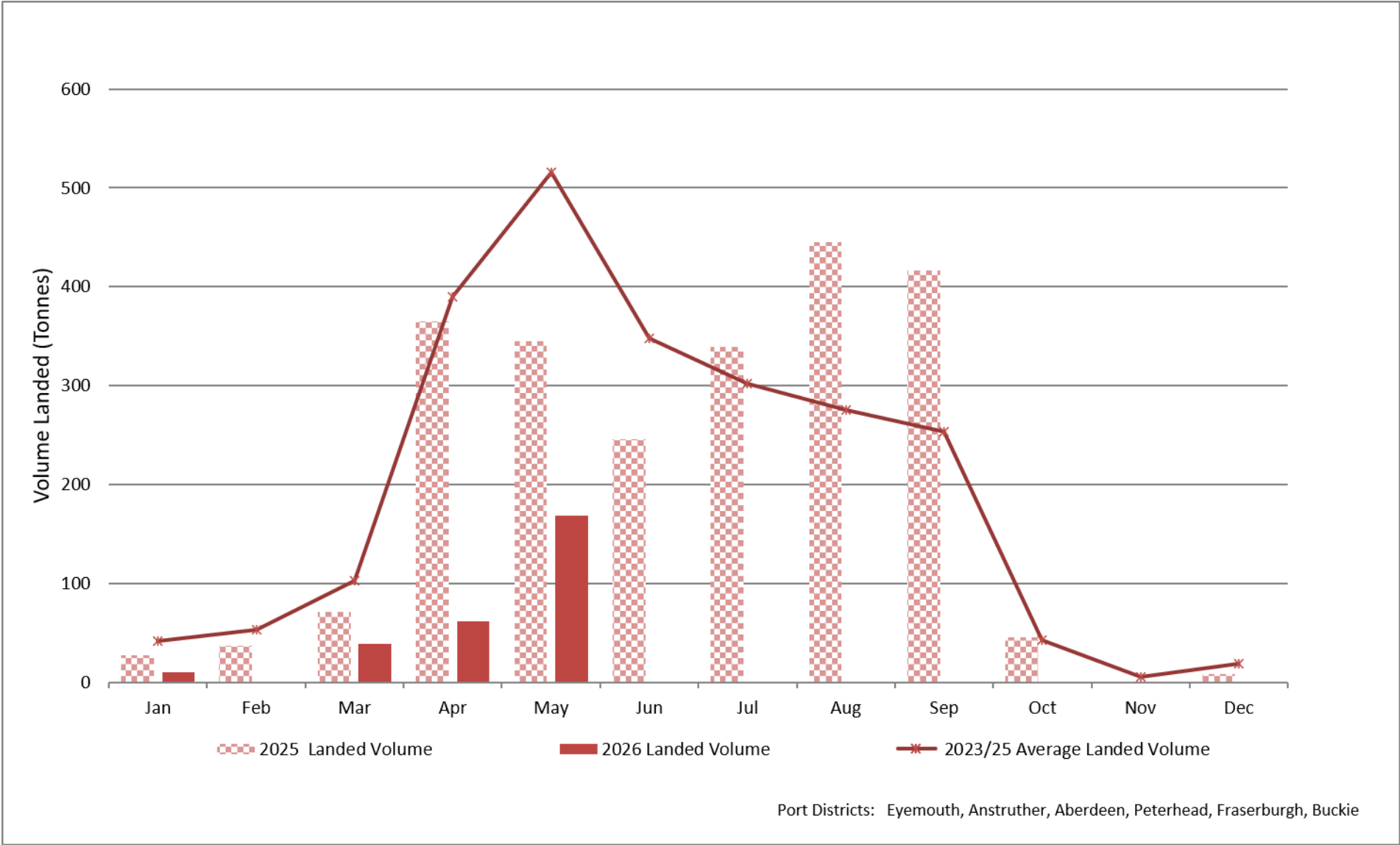
- Scottish landings have been separated into the following regions:
 - East Scotland
 - North Scotland
 - West Scotland
 - Orkney
 - Shetland
 - Western Isles
- Data is supplied by the Scottish Marine Analytical Unit and updated monthly.
- Landings data is provisional at this time; it should be interpreted as such and treated accordingly.
- Given this is provisional data - continuous adjustments will be made in future monthly updates.
- NB: Due to variances in volumes landed in different regions, not all vertical axes are the same.

- For the purposes of the Scottish landings shown in these updates. Landings from Port Districts have been grouped into the following regions:
- **East Scotland**
 - Buckie, Fraserburgh, Peterhead, Aberdeen, Anstruther, Eyemouth.
- **North Scotland**
 - Ullapool, Lochinver, Kinlochbervie, Scrabster.
- **West Scotland**
 - Ayr, Oban, Campbeltown, Mallaig, Portree.
- **Orkney**
- **Shetland**
- **Western Isles**

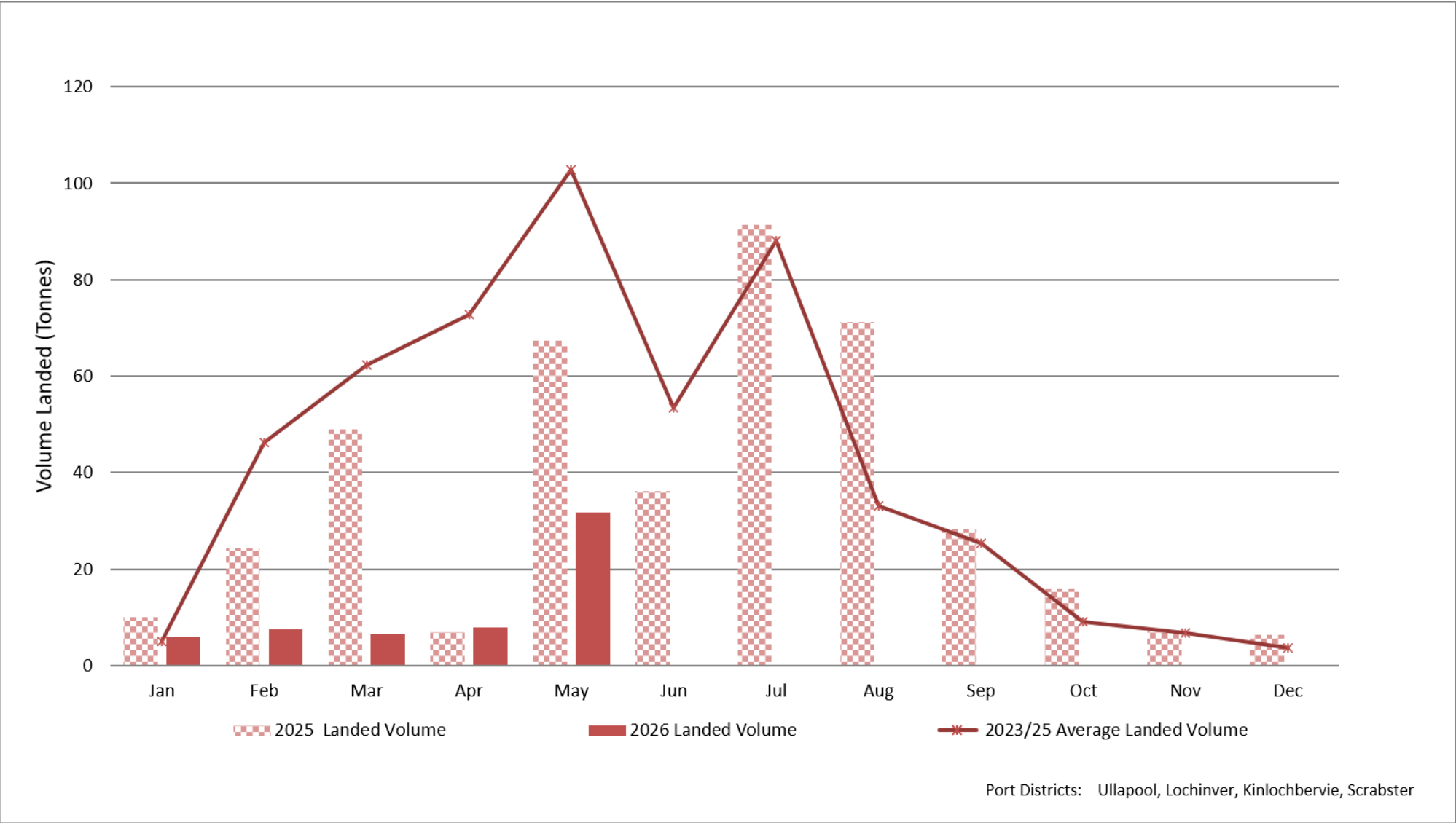

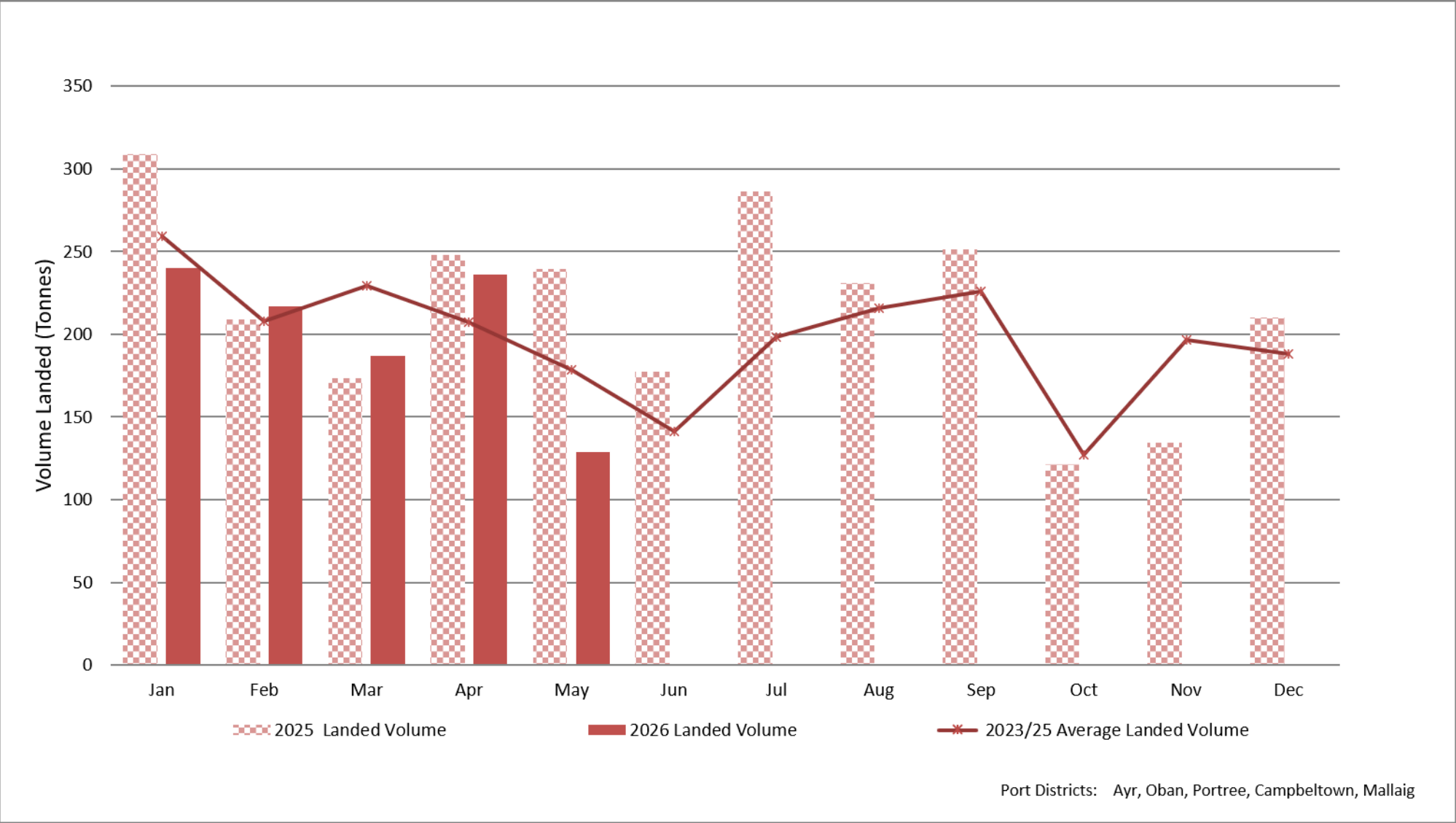

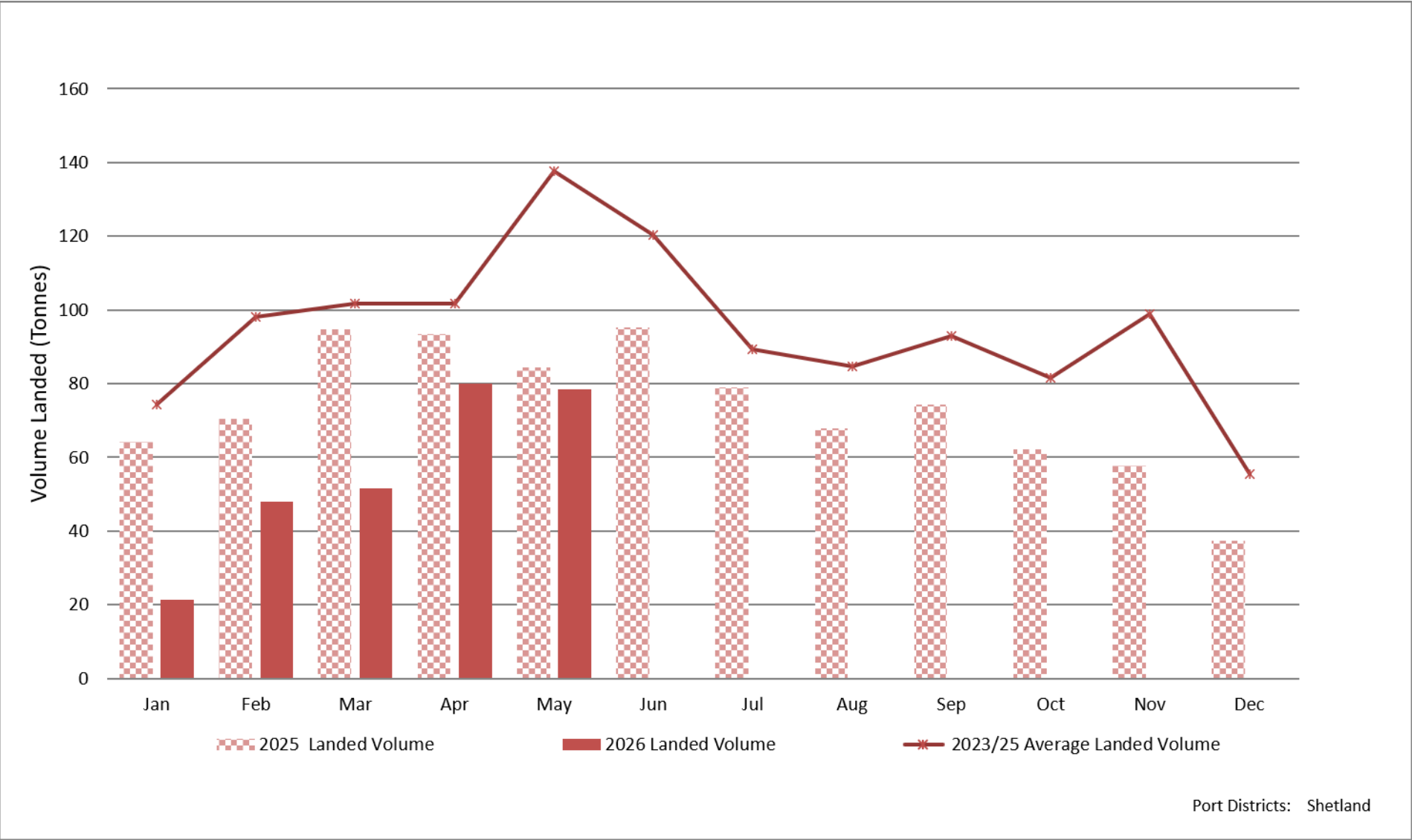

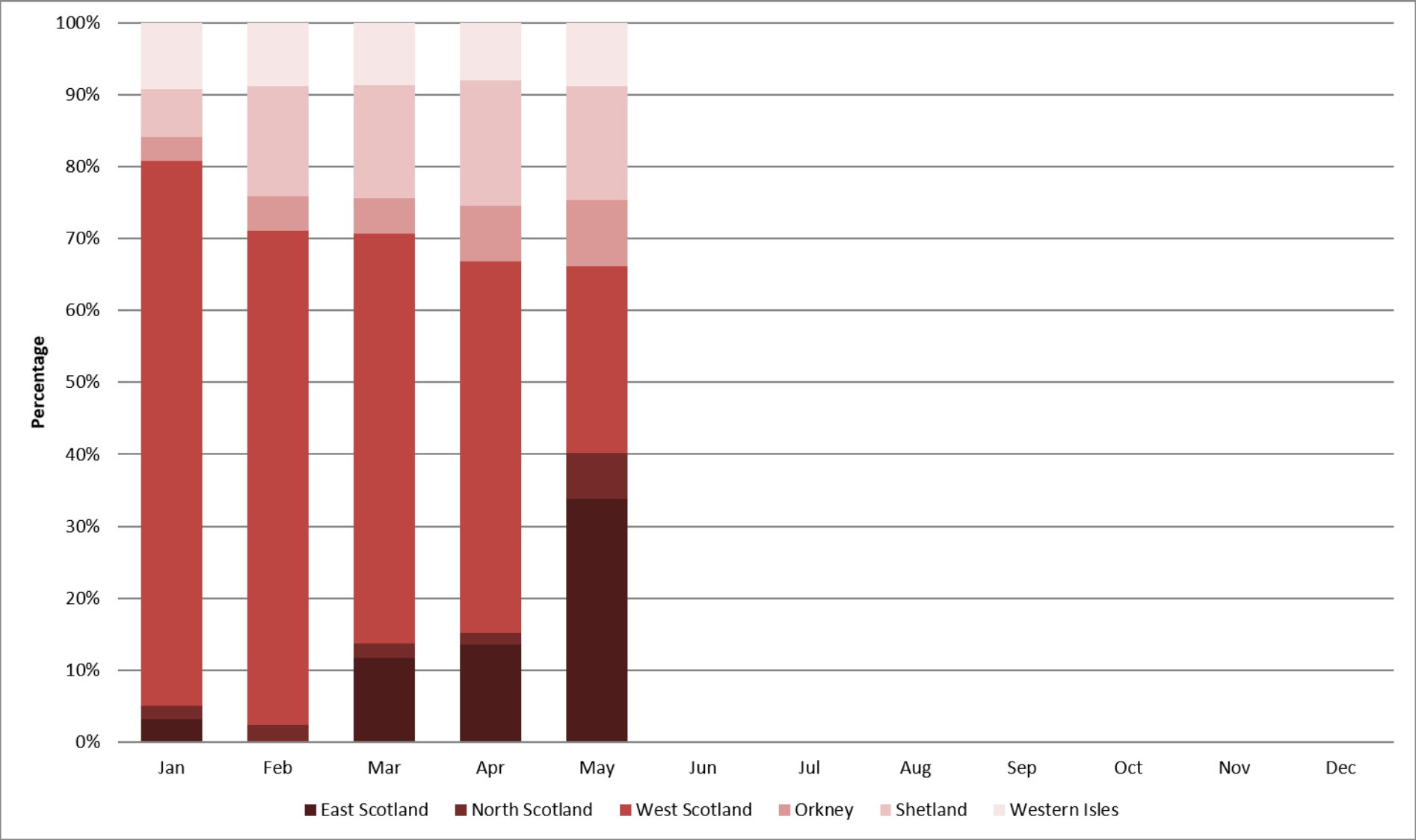
