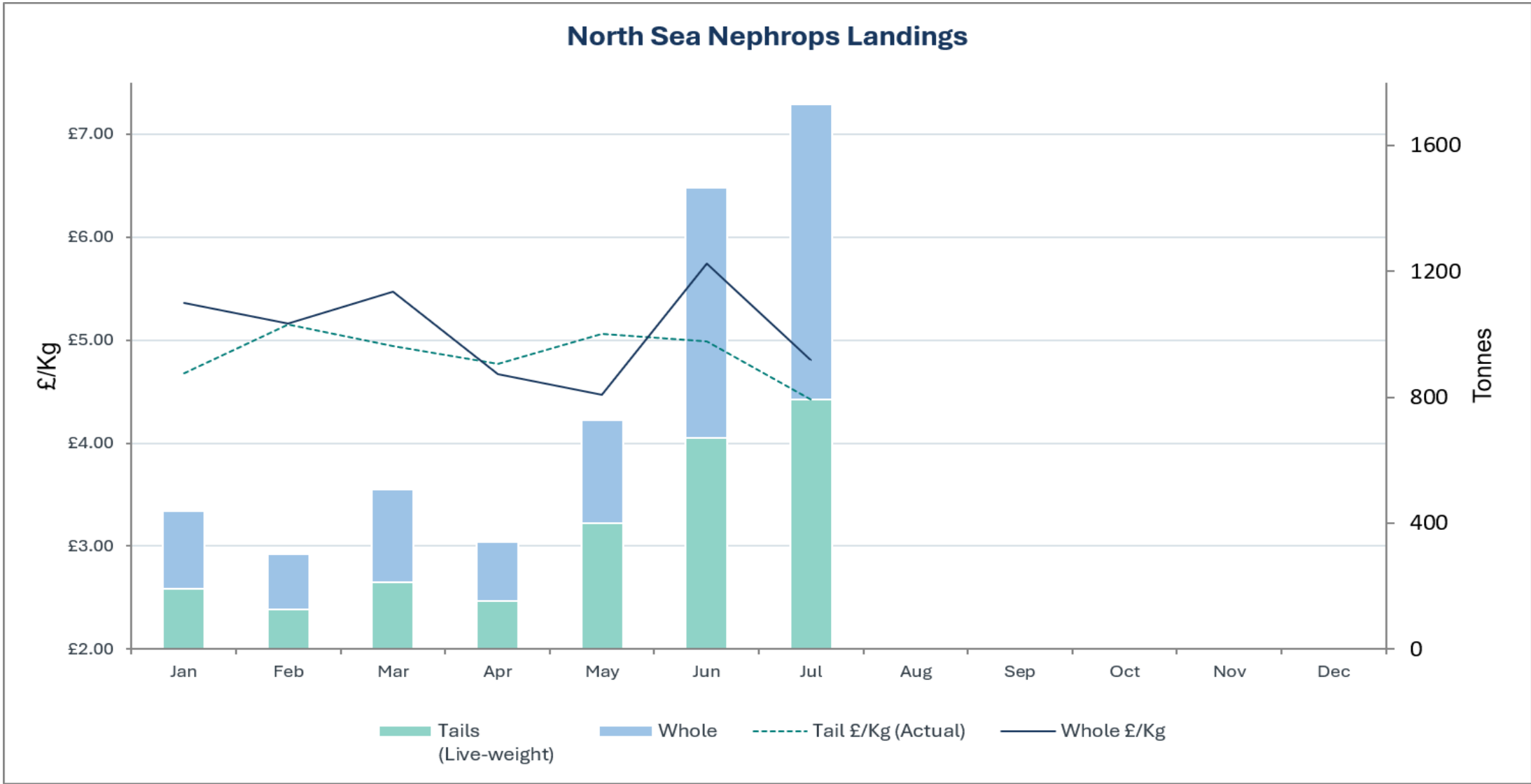

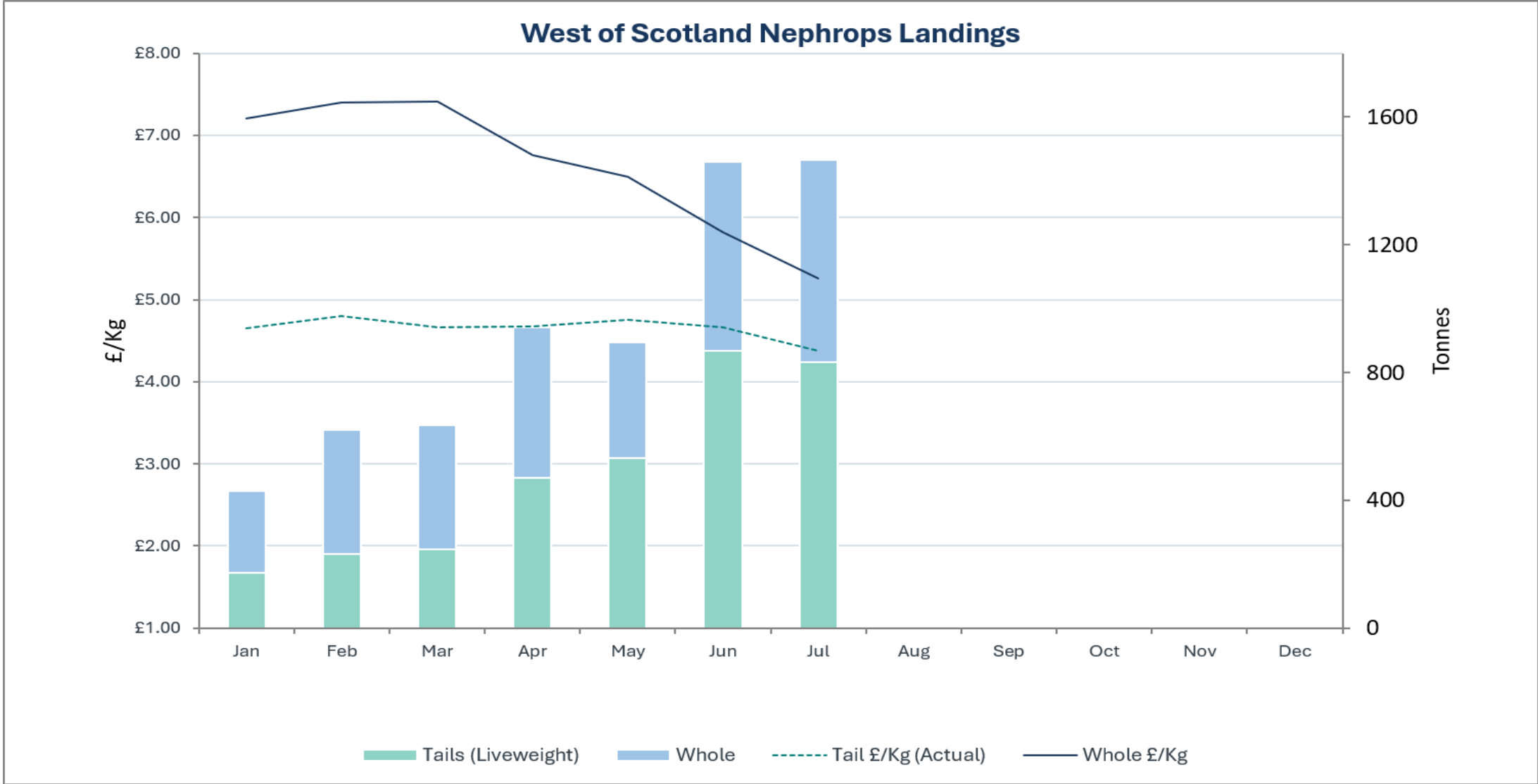
- These charts illustrate landings of *Nephrops* in Scotland by all UK vessels

2026: Scottish North Sea *Nephrops* landings & prices



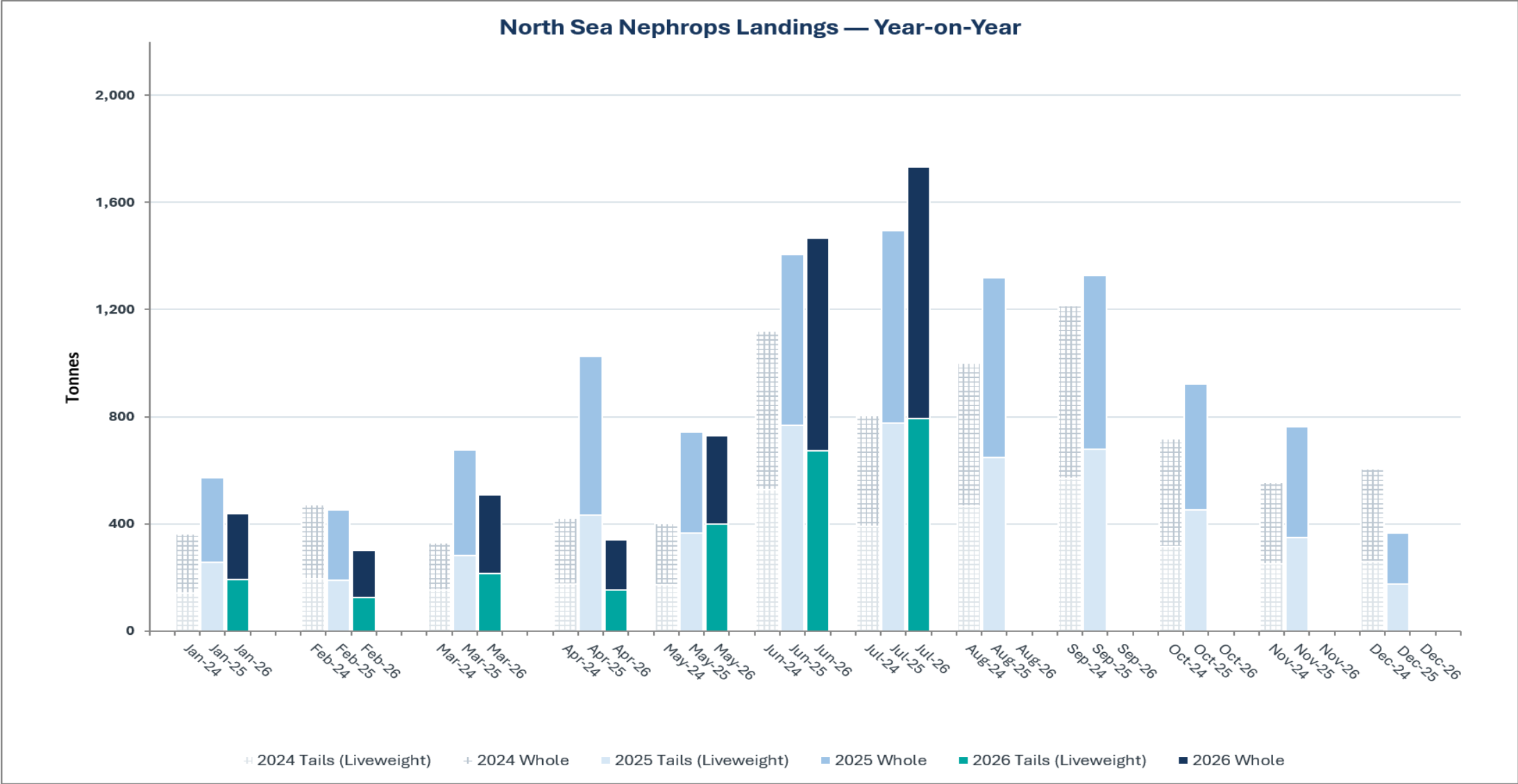

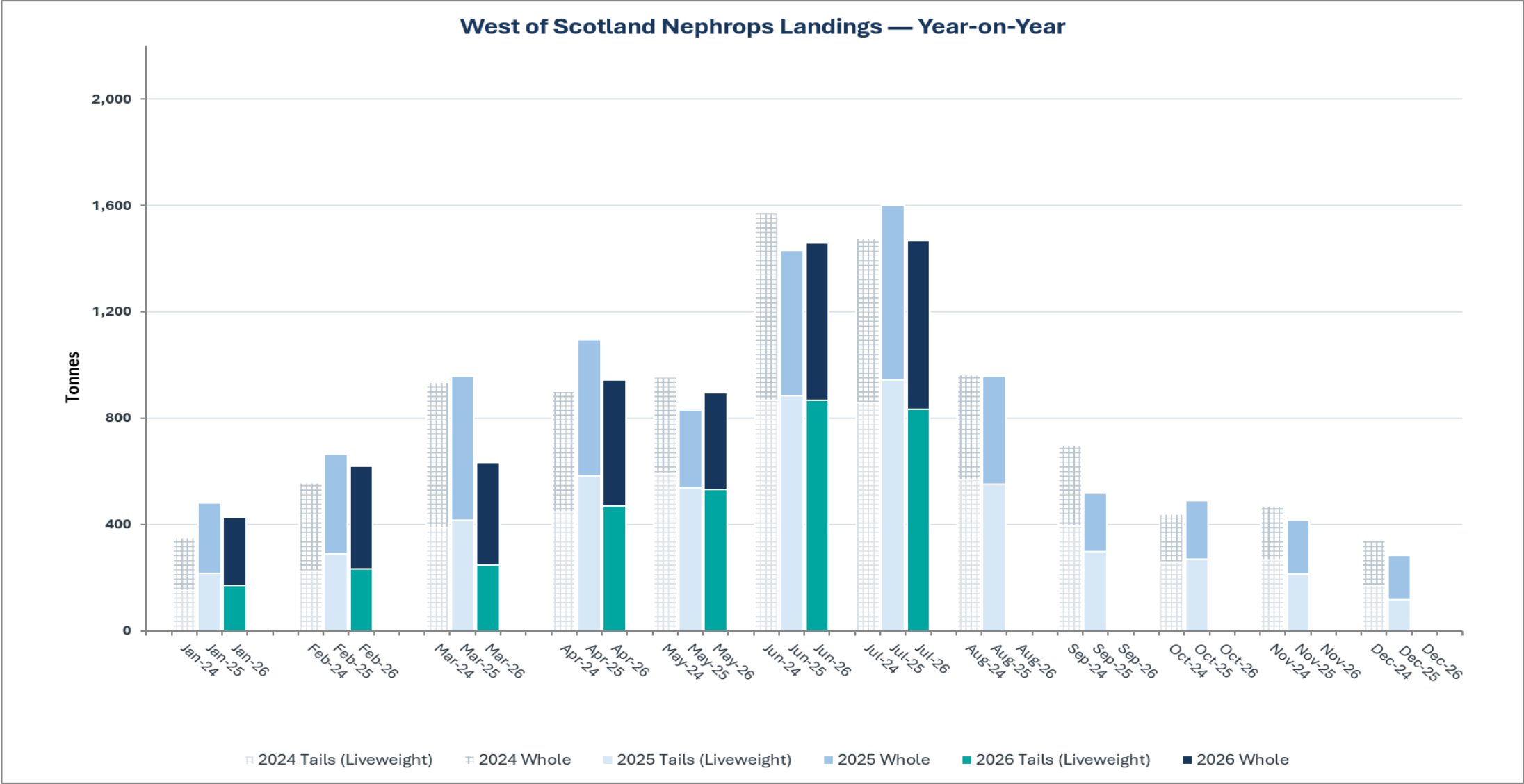
Scottish North Sea *Nephrops* landings 2024 - 2026

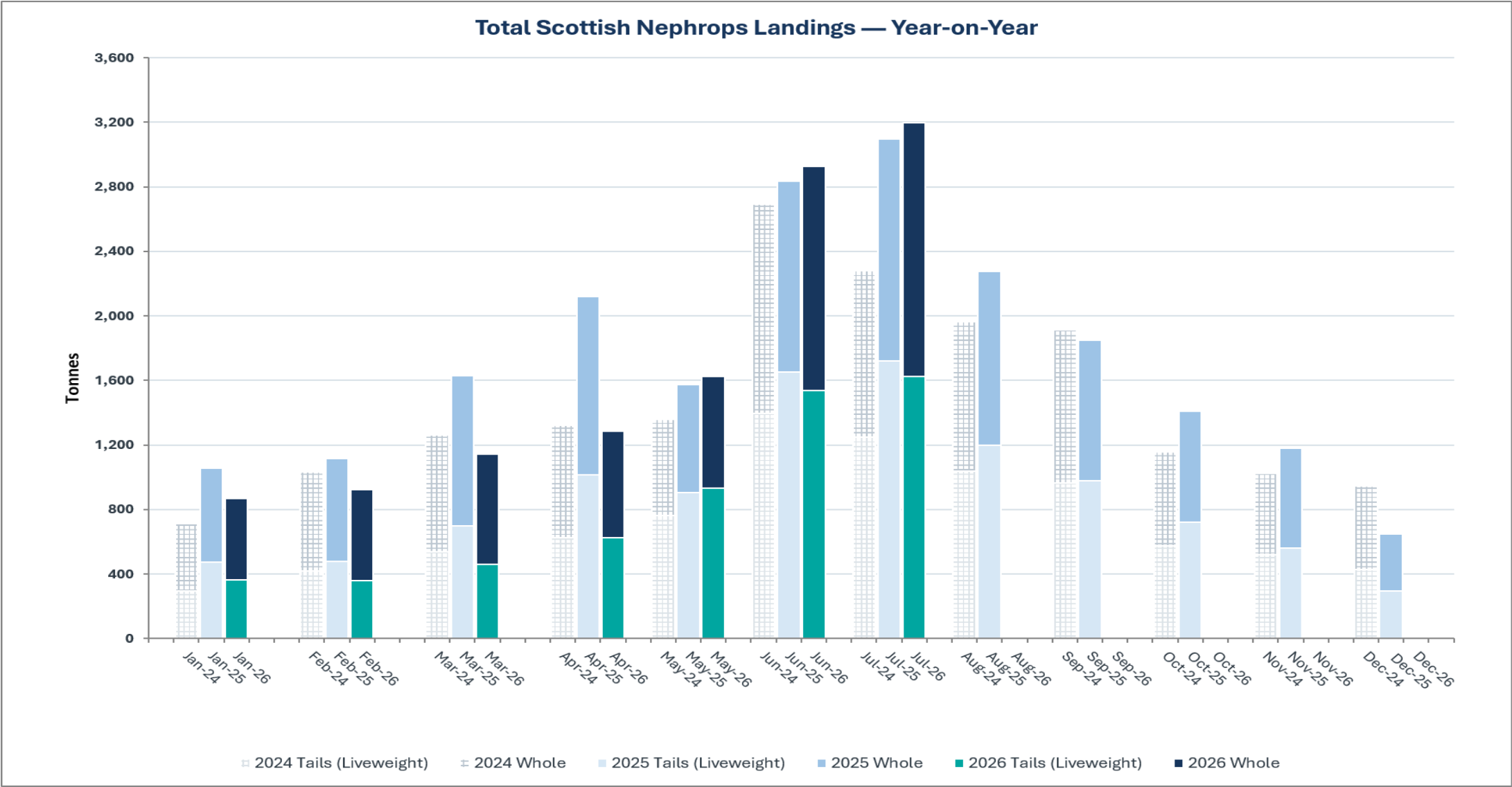
Scottish West of Scotland *Nephrops* landings 2024 - 2026

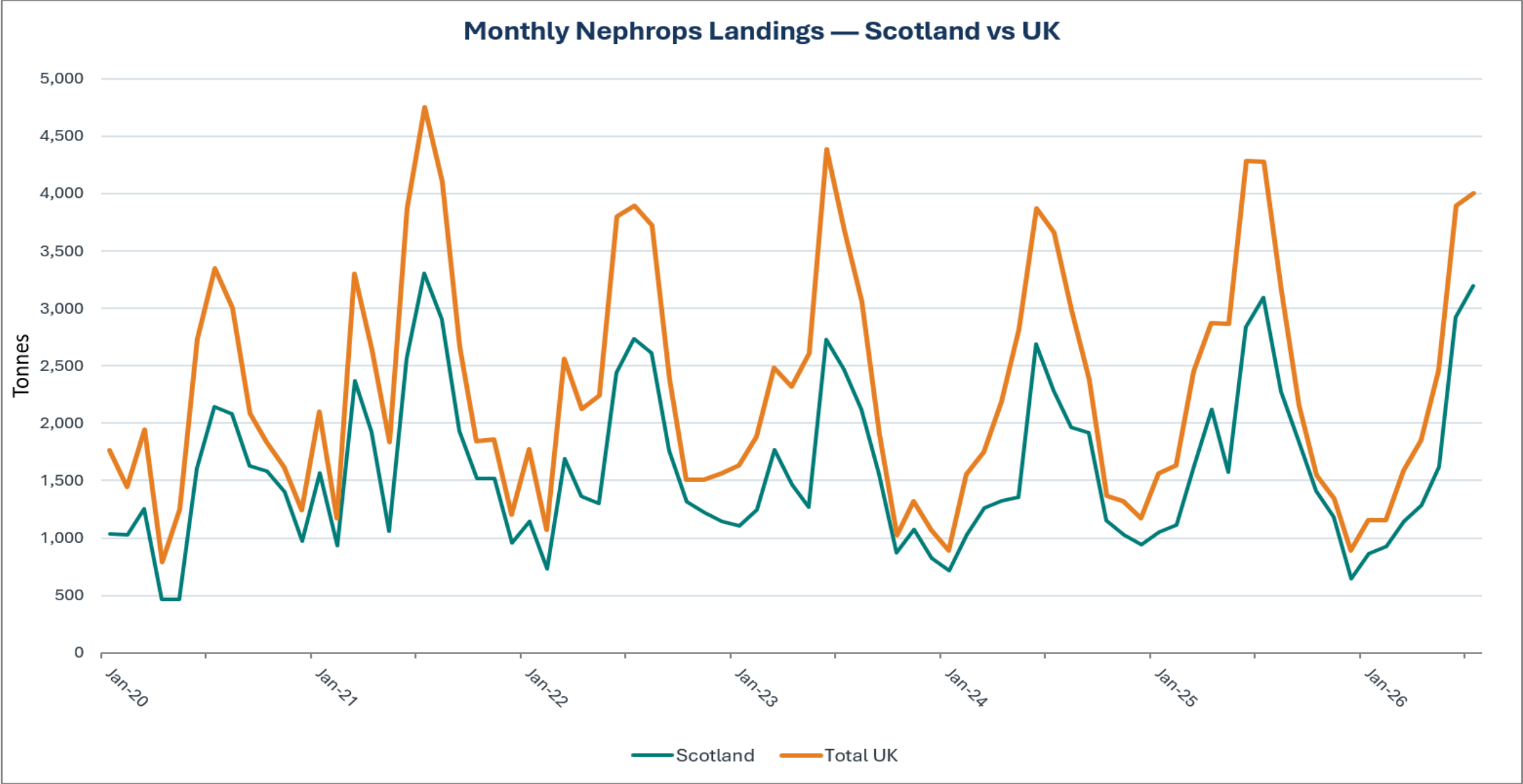


Total Scottish *Nephrops* landings 2024 - 2026

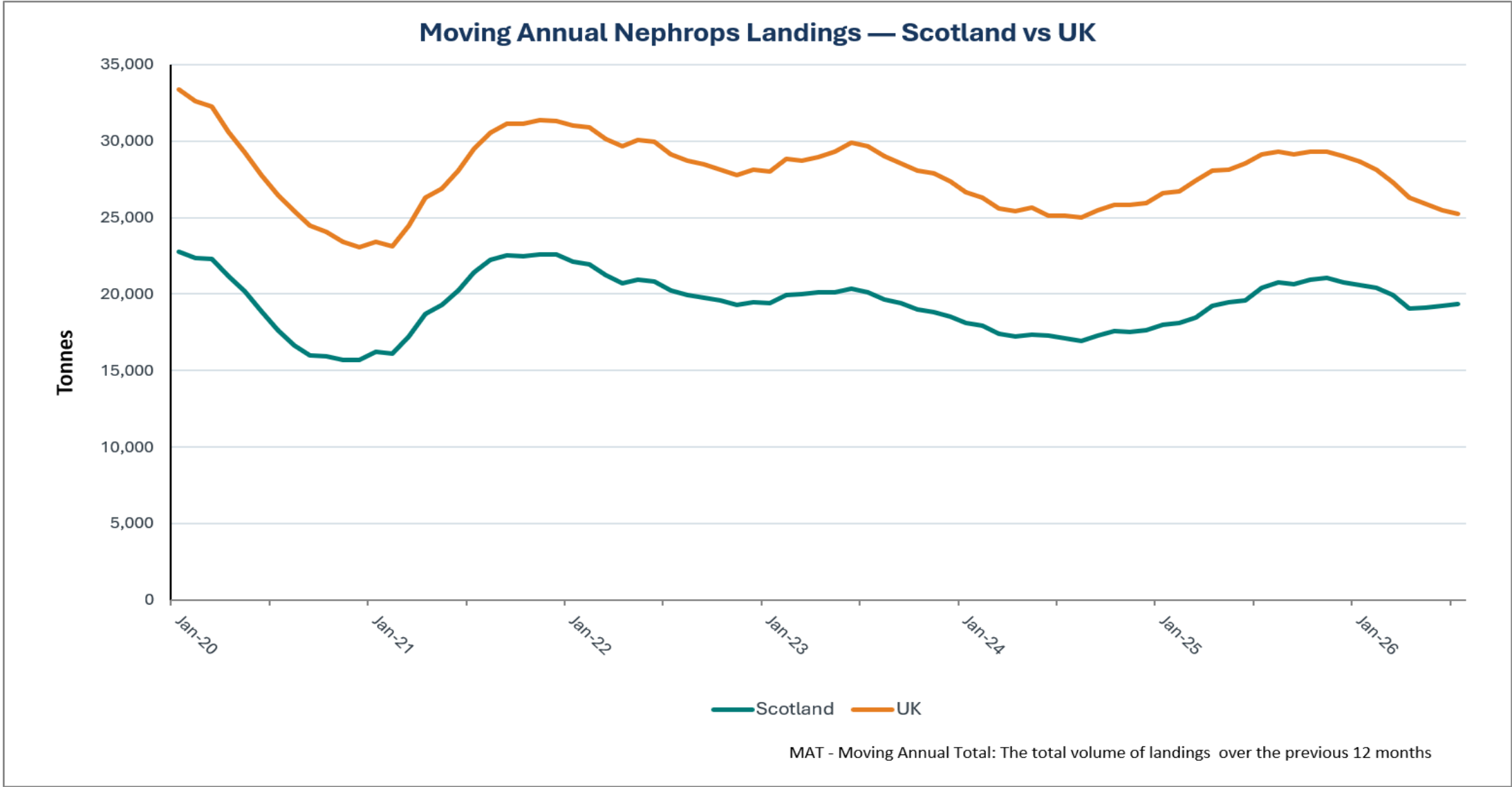
UK/Scottish Nephrops landings: 2020-2026
