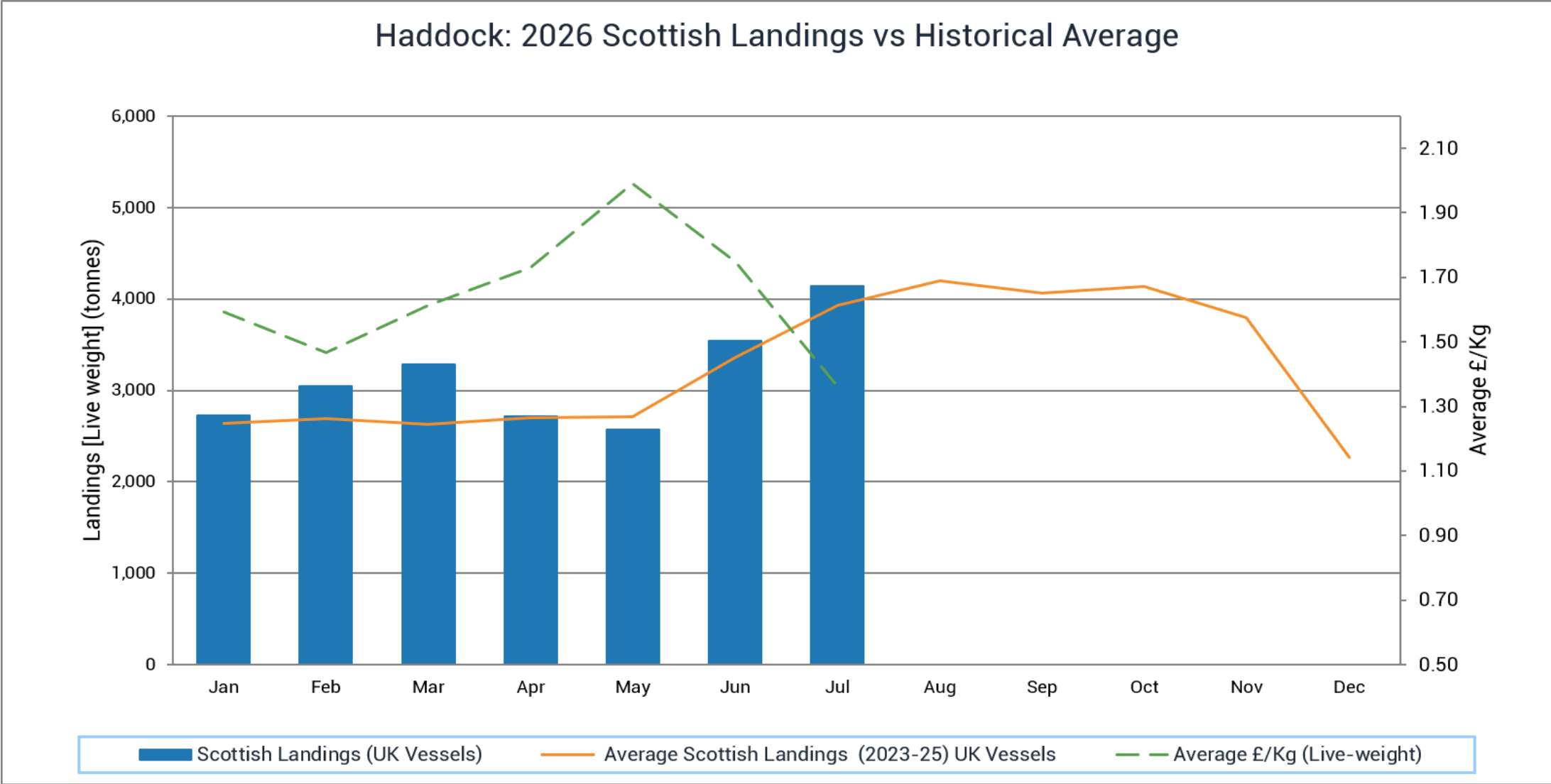


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Scottish whitefish landings

- These charts do not include landings by foreign vessels into Scotland
- Average historical landings into Scotland for the last three years from all UK vessels is also shown (2023 – 2025)
- All landings data is supplied by the Scottish Marine Analytical Unit and updated monthly. Landings and price data are provisional at this time and should be treated as such and interpreted accordingly
- Given the provisional nature of this data - necessary adjustments will be made in future updates

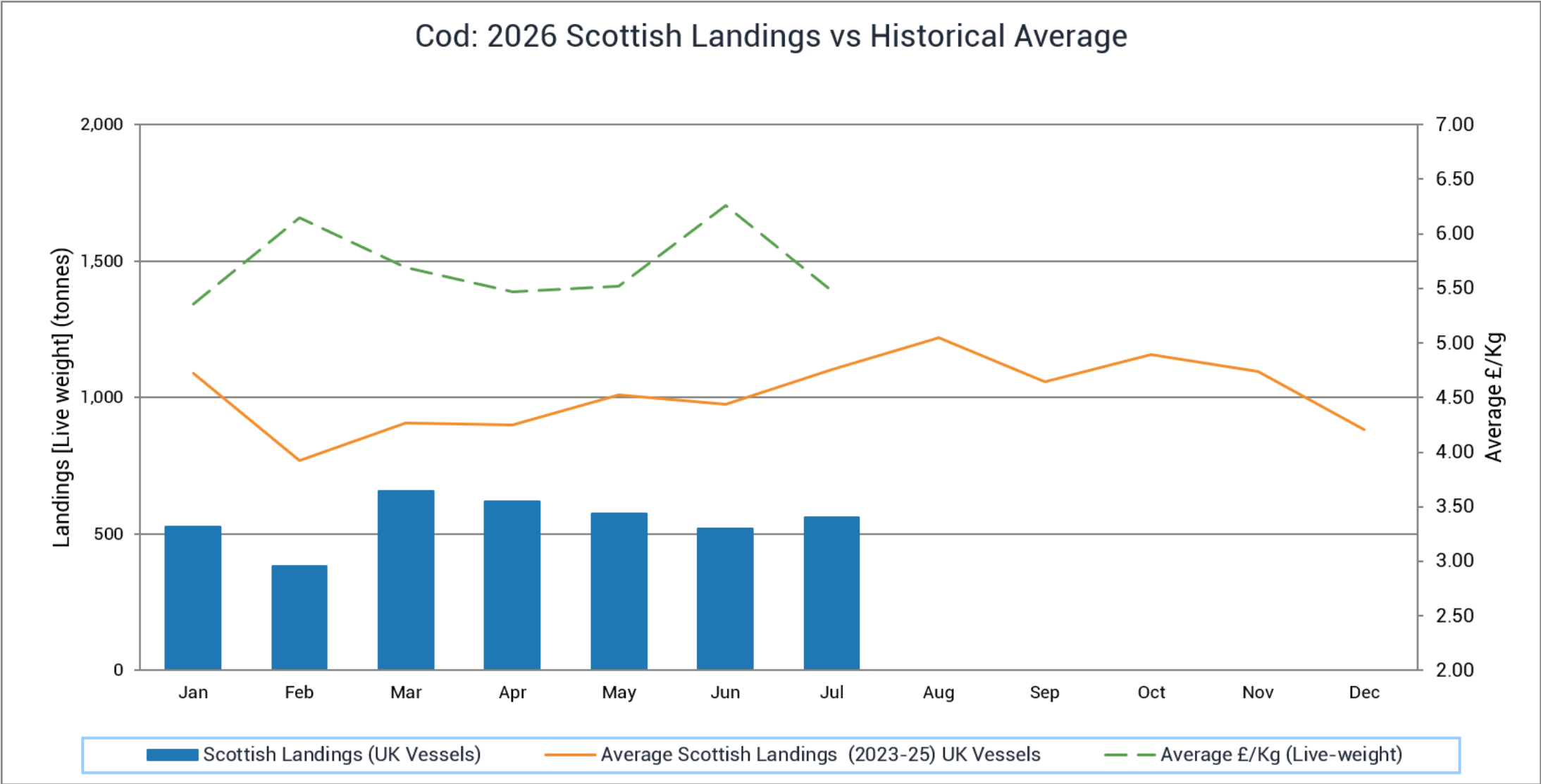
2026: Scottish monthly haddock landings. (live-weight)

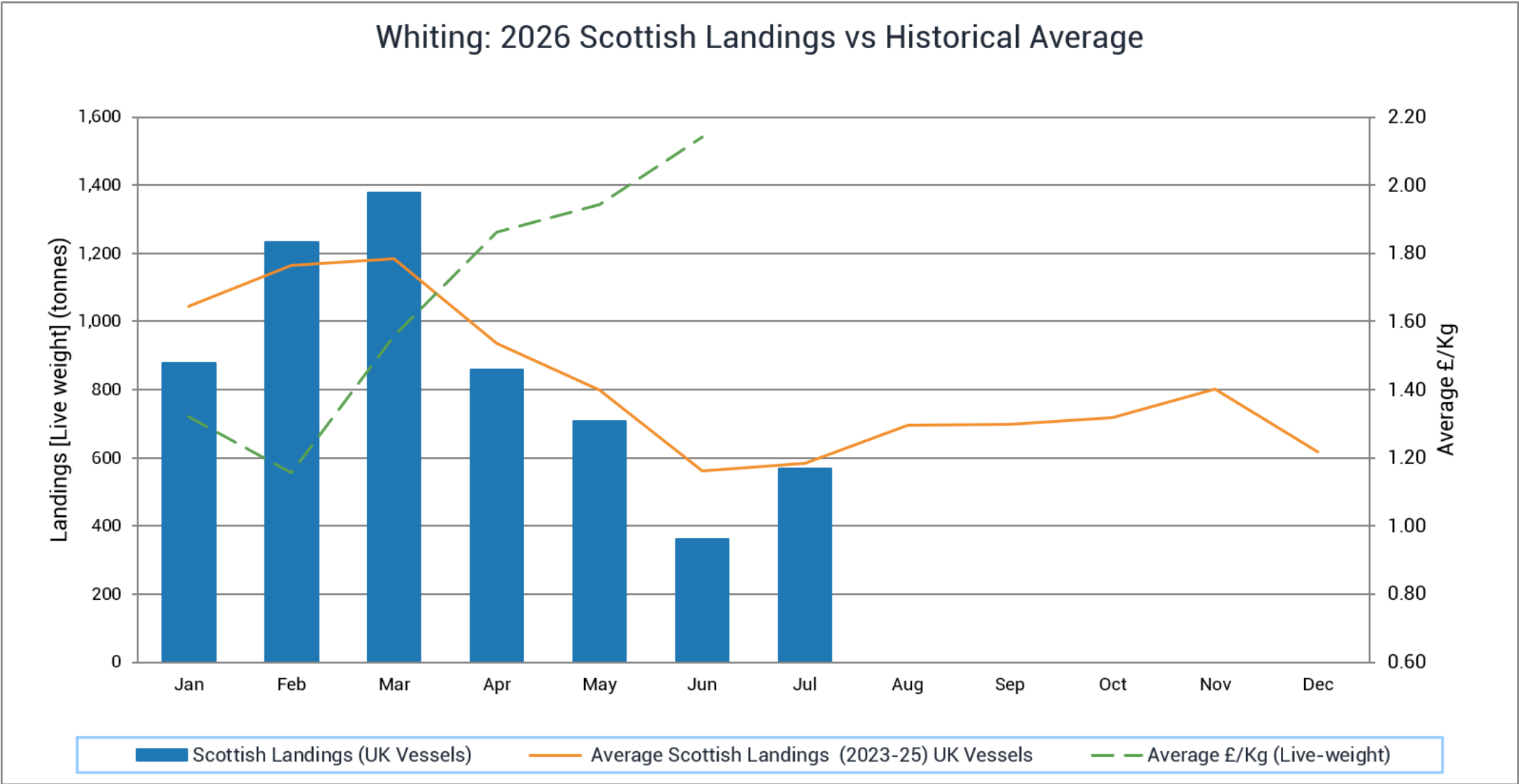


2026: Scottish monthly cod landings. (live-weight)

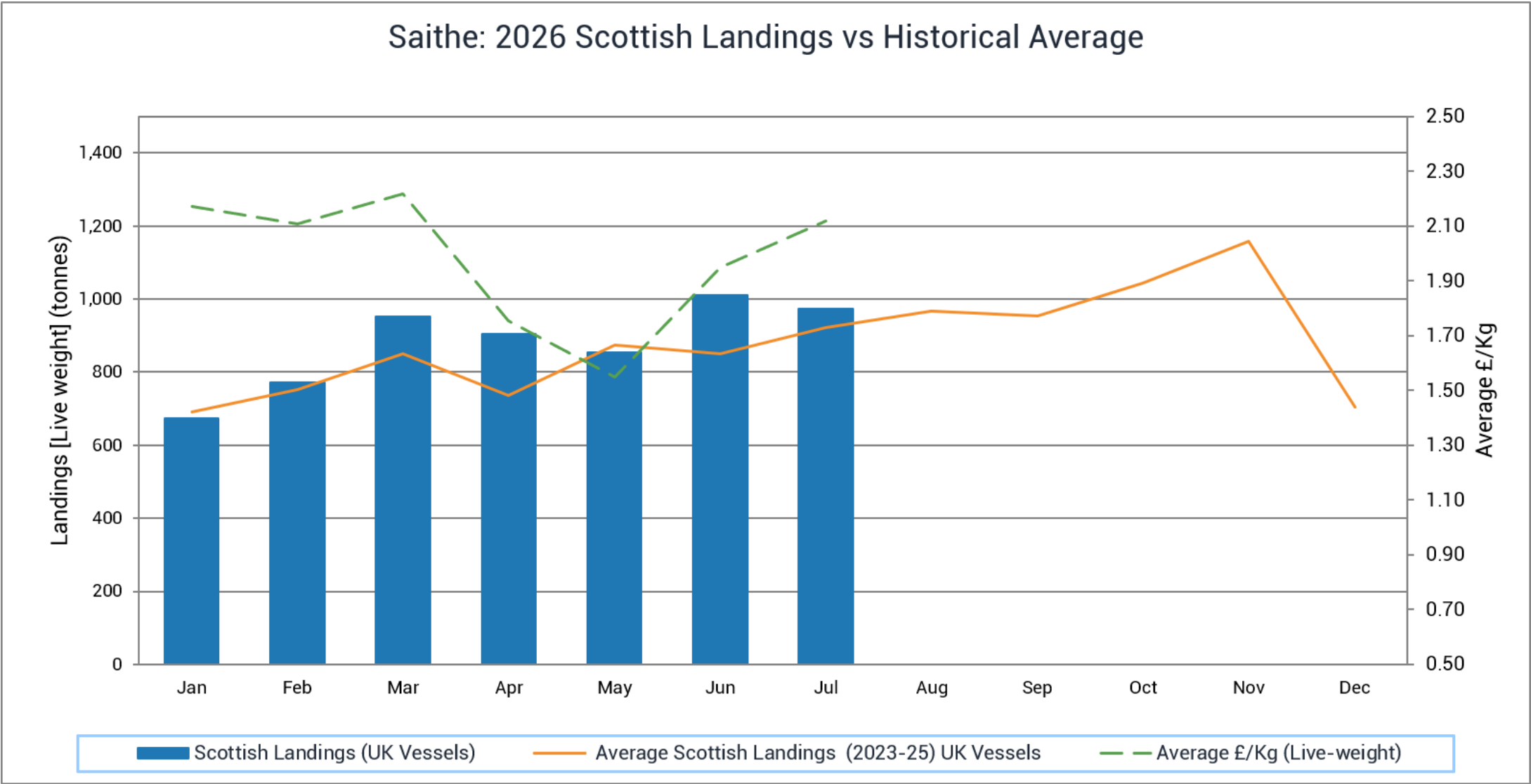

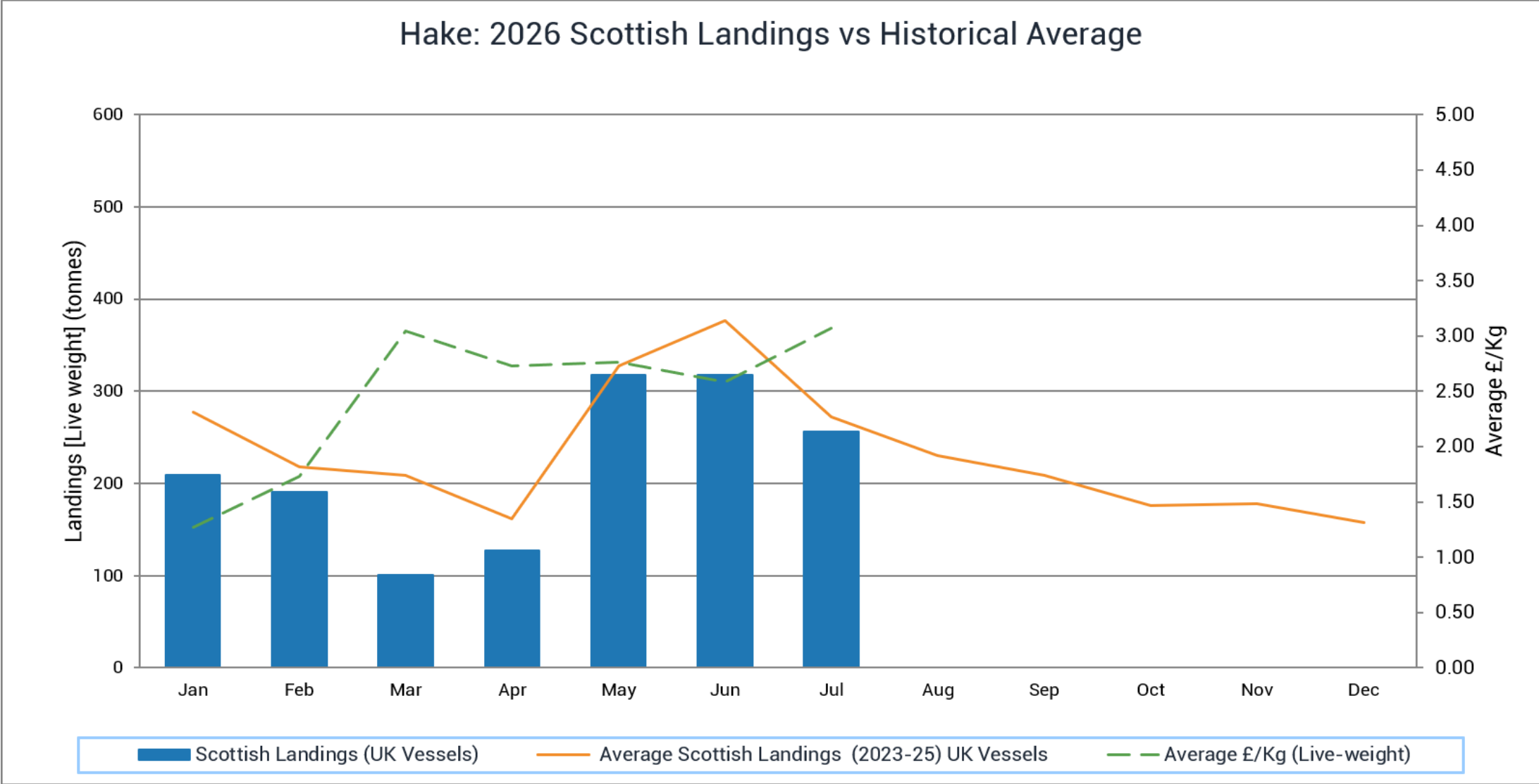

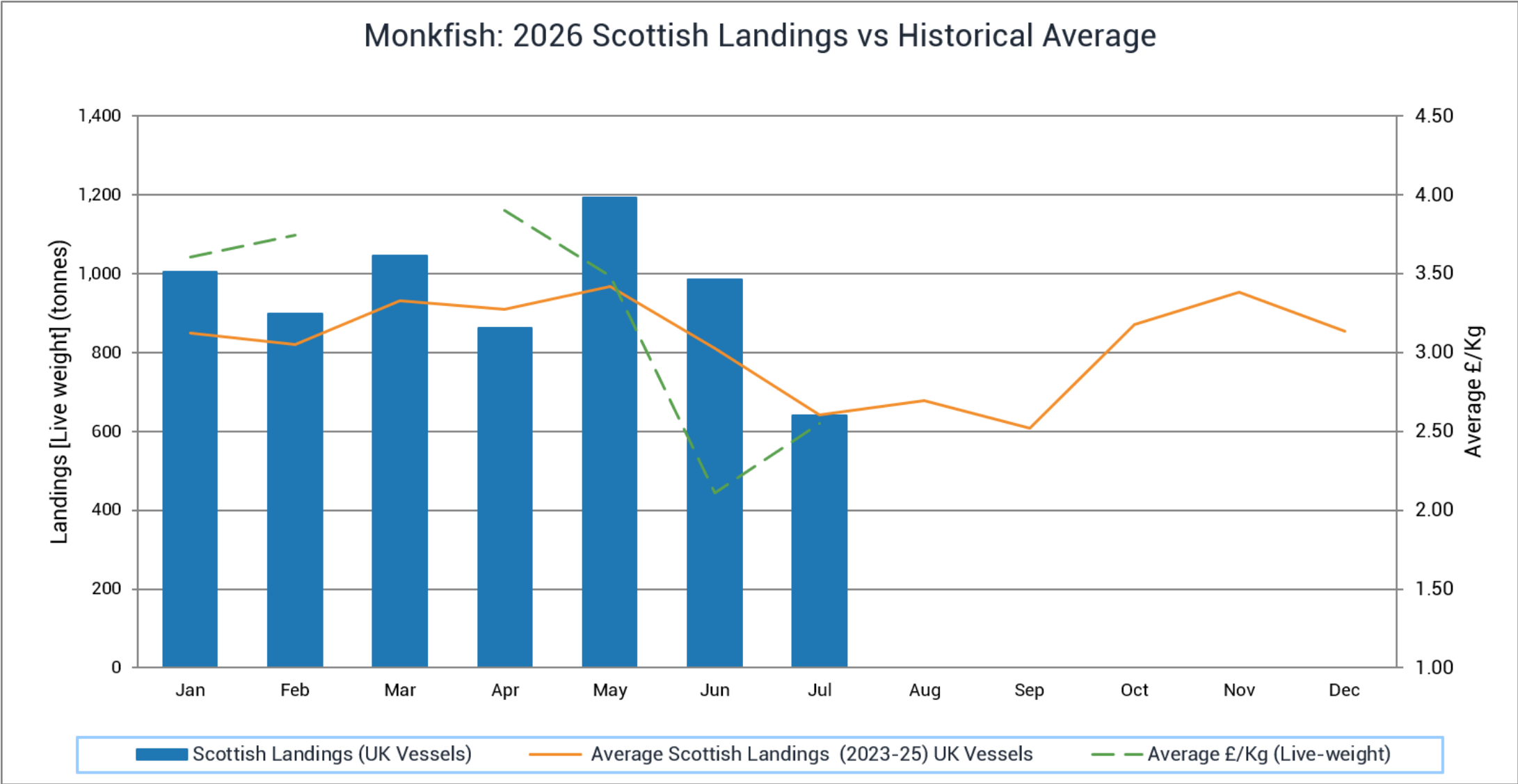

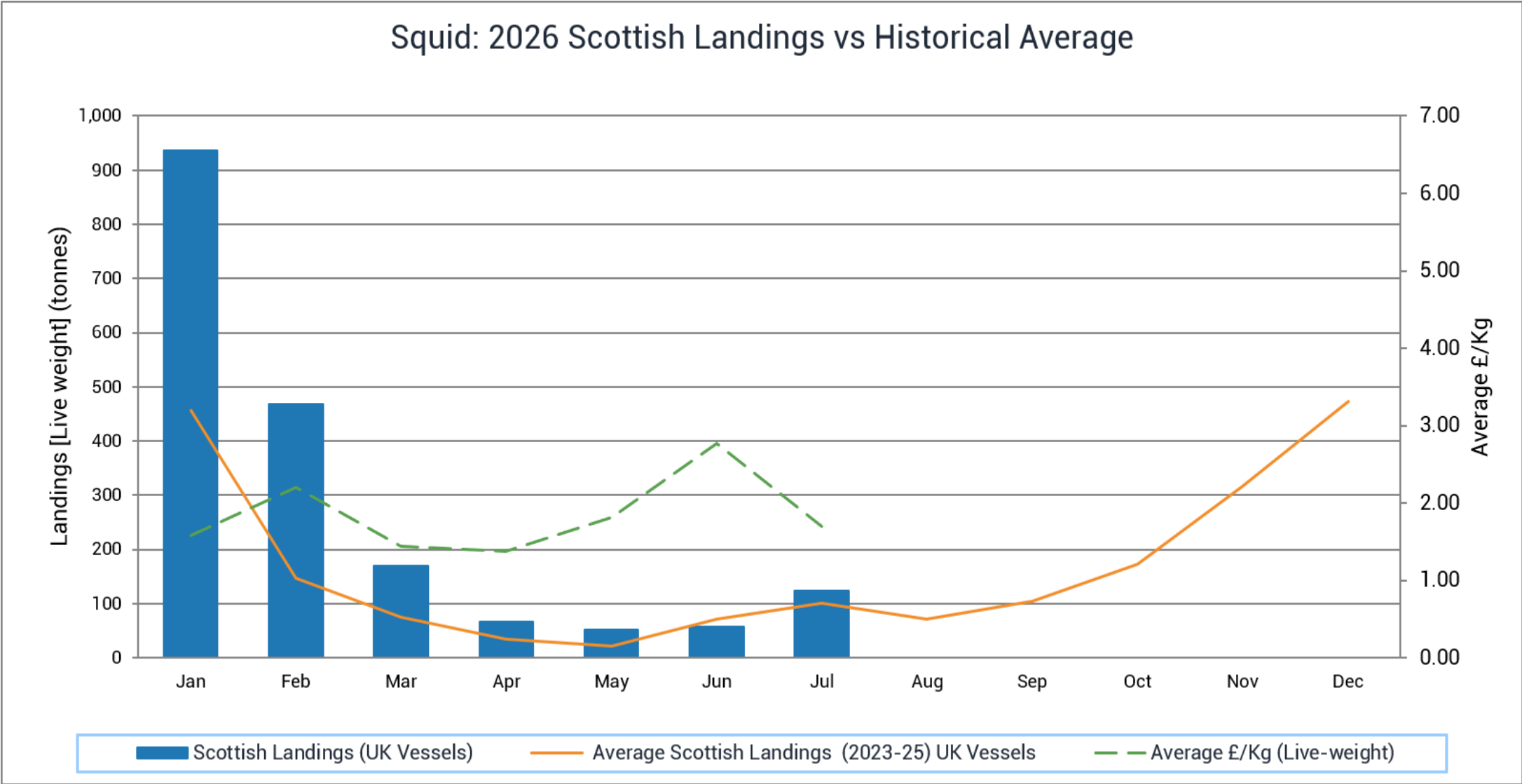

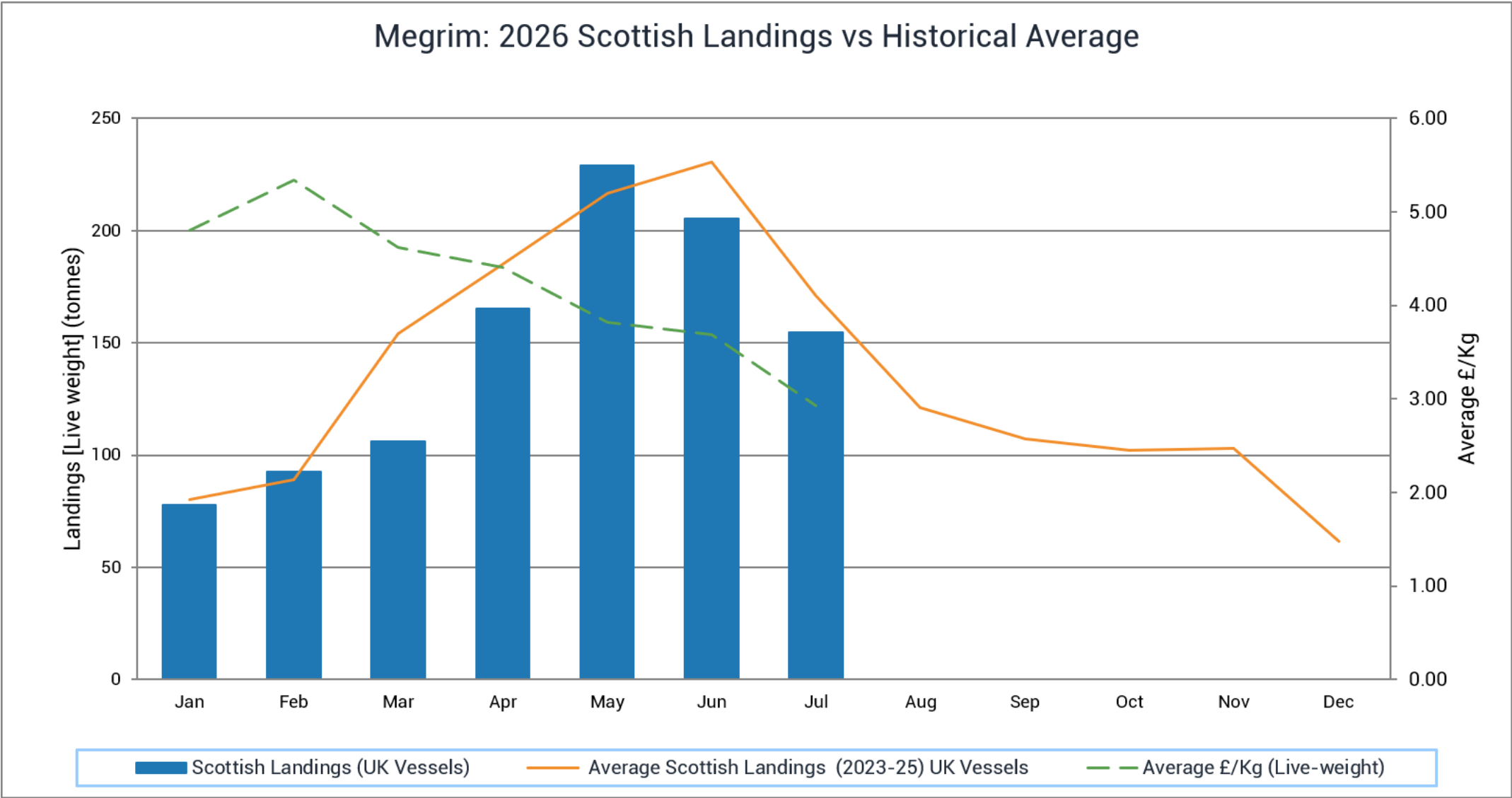

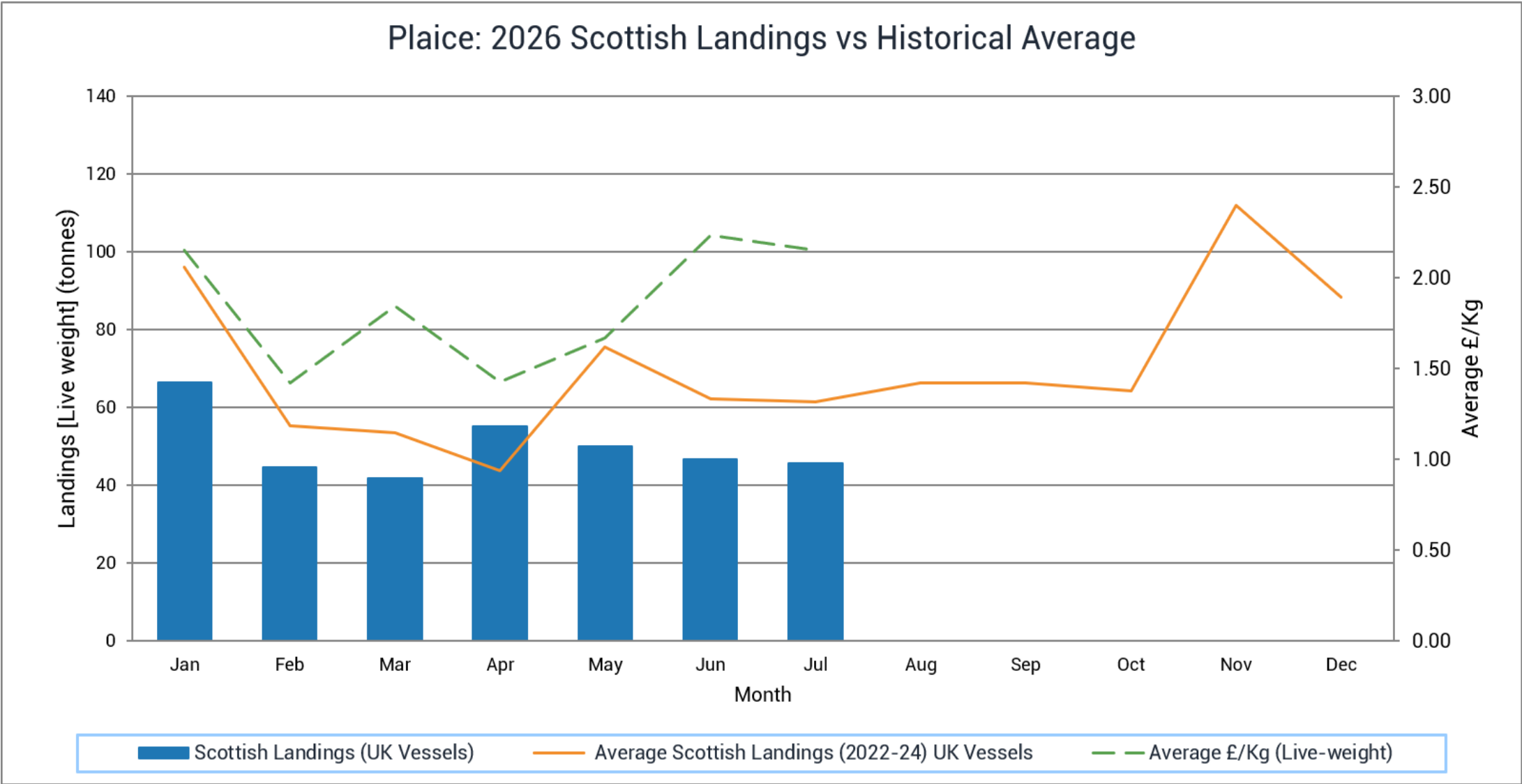
